Introduction

Hey there, Friend!

I used to be the girl who would start a job simply because I knew I needed an income. But, the moment things got frustrating or overwhelming, I'd be ready to leave. I could start a job one day and quit the next, thinking that was freedom...when in reality, I was running from what God was trying to teach me through work.

As I've grown more intentional in my relationship with God, I've learned that work...even a 9-5 is a part of His preparation process. I'll be honest, Bestie... I don't see myself working a 9-5 forever.

May these scriptures that have been helping me remind you that you carry the authority of as a child of the King of kings and Lord of lords...even at your desk, your register, or your cubicle.

You are not just clocking in; you're being called in to represent Christ wherever you go.

Let's build by faith, one workday at a time.

Day 1 - Colossians 3:23 (CSB)

"Whatever you do, do it from the heart, as something done for the Lord and not for people,"

Reflection:

Even on long days, remember your work is worship. You represent Christ in every meeting, task, and customer interaction. Excellence is a form of praise.

Faith in Action:

Start your day saying, "Lord, I work for you today. Let my attitude reflect your grace. Thank you for giving me the wisdom in all that I do."

Day 2 - Matthew 6:9-10 (NIV)

"This, then, is how you should pray: "Our Father in heaven, hallowed be your name, your kingdom come, your will be done, on earth as it is in heaven."

Reflection:

Your workplace can become your mission field. Pray before you start, and God will use even small tasks for a big impact.

Faith in Action:

Before you clock in, pray the Lord's will in your job, over yourself, and over others daily. The results will eventually shock you.

Day 3 - Jeremiah 33:3 (NIV)

"Call to me and I will answer you and tell you great and unsearchable things you do not know."

Reflection:

God wants to be part of your workday decisions. Whether it's how to handle a customer or respond to an email, invite Him into it.

Faith in Action:

No matter how big or small, remember prayer is your direct line to God. Whenever you feel overwhelmed at work, whisper a quick prayer instead of stressing.

Day 4 - James 1:19 (NIV)

"My dear brothers and sisters, take note of this: Everyone should be quick to listen, slow to speak and slow to become angry,"

Reflection:

When tension rises, faith teaches patience. God's Spirit, The Holy Spirit, gives you wisdom to respond with grace instead of reaction.

Faith in Action:

Be first to listen, speak slowly depending on God's Spirit to lead you, allow your faith to guide you, not your emotions! Ask the Holy Spirit to help you pause before replying to anything that frustrates you today. Simply say, "Holy Spirit, help me."

Day 5 - Proverbs 3:5-6 (NIV)

"Trust in the LORD with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding; in all your ways submit to him, and he will make your paths straight."

Reflection:

Even in confusing work seasons, God is orchestrating your steps. Don't lean on what you see, lean on Who you know. Allow your trust in God to guide your decisions.

Faith in Action:

Write a short prayer surrendering your work goals and future to God, trusting Him to guide your next move.

Bestie, your 9-5 is not separate from your faith...If you didn't understand that, Read it again \bigcirc Your job is the ground where your light shines brightest. Keep showing up, praying through, and trusting God with your career path.
